## Scholarship Application Harrison Co. Farm Bureau

The Harrison Co. Farm Bureau will award two (2) \$1,000.00 scholarships to deserving students from Harrison Co. schools. The applicant must have been a member of the Harrison Co. 4-H or a bonafide FFA chapter from Harrison County. The recipient must be a current year graduate and must attend a college or university in the fall of the same year. The applicant must have been a bonafide member of Harrison Co. 4-H or a Harrison Co. FFA chapter for a minimum of three (3) years during their high school career. The scholarship will be awarded based upon scholarship, participation in 4-H or FFA activities, and leadership.

- 1. The Harrison Co. Farm Bureau shall screen all applicants and select finalists.
- 2. The award will be presented at a time and place chosen by the Harrison Co. Farm Bureau.
- 3. The scholarship check will be mailed directly to the recipient's college or university by September 1<sup>st</sup>, after receipt of proof of enrollment at \$500.00 per semester.

## Scholarship Eligibility

- 1. Applicant's family must be a member of Harrison Co. Farm Bureau.
- 2. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior enrolled in a Harrison Co. school for a minimum of three (3) years and be a resident of Harrison Co.
- 3. Applicant must have maintained an <u>un-weighted</u> grade point average of 80 or higher on a 100 point scale.
- 4. Chapter for a minimum of three (3) years during their high school career.
- 5. The decision of the Harrison Co. Farm Bureau scholarship selection committee shall be final.
- 6. Applicants must have a completed application on file at the Harrison Co. Farm Bureau no later than April 1, 2008. NOT POSTMARKED BY APRIL 1<sup>ST</sup>.
- 7. No applicant will be denied said scholarship because of race, sex, religion, handicap, national or ethnic origin.
- 8. Applicant must attend college, university or trade school in the state of Texas.
