EARTH-KIND® LANDSCAPE DESIGN AND MANAGEMENT SCHOOL

During this unique educational experience, you will learn how to design, plant, and manage a landscape that is beautiful, low maintenance, heat and drought tolerant, and the ultimate in environmental responsibility. No previous design, plant, or management knowledge is needed.

Presented in a very time- and travel-efficient format, this 2 day course will take place in Marshall the weekend of **April 4th and 5th**, and consist of an in-depth classroom program that will last 8 hours and the registration fee for this part is \$50.00 per household. Followed by a personalized extended (10 hour) landscape design consultation to be conducted the second day for a fee of \$100.00 per household.

Dr. Steve George, Professor and Extension Landscape Specialist with the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service and creator of the *Earth-Kind® Environmental Landscape Management System*, is the lead instructor and will personally conduct all of the design consultations.

When the course is complete, you will have been given a wealth of landscape knowledge and will leave with a labeled working landscape plan for the major landscape area of your choice.
