Brian McGaughy Memorial Scholarship & Harrison 4-H PAC Scholarship

The Harrison 4-H (PAC) provides one \$1,000 Brian McGaughy Memorial Scholarship, and other scholarships as approved by the PAC budget each year, to eligible 4-H graduating seniors to help defray college/university costs. The scholarships are funded each year from various fundraising endeavors carried out by Harrison County 4-H PAC and Harrison County 4-H members.

Brian McGaughy was an active 4-H member from age 9 until he graduated from Marshall High School in 1987. He was killed in an automobile accident shortly before he was to leave for Texas Tech University in Lubbock. A memorial scholarship was established in 1988.

If you are interested in applying, you must meet the following qualifications:

- Must be an active and enrolled 4-H member 2 of the 4 years of high school including the year the scholarship is submitted. High school includes public, private, and homeschool.
- Must be a graduating senior at the high school level.
- Must be active in at least two 4-H projects (horse, beef, clothing & textiles, food & nutrition, etc.) during his/her senior year.
- Complete and submit a senior record book for that year. The record book will be used in determining winners. The record book has the same due date as the scholarship application.
- The application form and certification form are due in the County Extension office by June 3, 2019 at 5 pm. Please notice that the certification form requires the signatures of you, your 4-H club manager and County Extension Agent.

The Winner(s)/Recipient(s) will be notified within 2 weeks following the due date of the application. Payment will be made in two semester installments to the school of higher learning, in recipient's name, following proof of enrollment from school of higher learning. 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Application must be complete all spaces. Read carefully. Do not add pages (except where instructed to do so). Your replies must be retained within the allotted area.
