

PEACH AND BLACKBERRY SALAD

INGREDIENTS:

Dressing

- 1/4 cup extra virgin olive oil
- 1 lemon, zest and juice
- 1 tablespoon fresh basil, minced
- 1/2 teaspoon salt

Salad

- 6 ounces baby spinach and spring mix
- 1/4 cup feta cheese, reduced fat, crumbled
- 1/4 cup almonds, sliced
- 1/2 pint fresh blackberries, halved
- 2 peaches, medium, sliced

DIRECTIONS:

- Wash your hands and clean your food preparation area.
- Wash all produce and fruit before preparing salad.
- Using a canning jar, pour in olive oil, zest, and juice of 1 lemon, minced fresh basil, and salt. Cover the jar with lid and shake till blended well, let sit.
- Toss spinach and spring mix in a large bowl. Top greens with feta cheese, walnut pieces, blackberries, and sliced peaches.
- Pour dressing over salad and gently toss.

Water Well Screening

TEXAS WELL OWNER NETWORK

RESOURCES HELP LANDOWNERS PROTECT GROUNDWATER



The “Well Informed” Texas Well Owner Network (TWON) program is an educational program that gives well owners the opportunity to have their well water samples screened for common contaminants including fecal coliform, E. coli bacteria, nitrates, arsenic and high salinity. The screening of the water samples is followed by a 1-hour explanation of the results, water well protection practices and focuses on wellhead protection and recommendations for remediating well contamination.
